When will you receive service?

Will you're location be placed on a fixed schedule or will you receive service when they can squeeze you in?

Who will be in you location?

Many companies will switch employees to locations frequently, or worse, allow their staff to bring others with them. Do you really want to see strangers holding the keys to your bldg?

How long have they been in business?

Do they really know what they are doing?
